PROGRAM COVER CONTEST

The 2022 CTE Fall Conference Committee is seeking entries from middle and high school students for the conference program cover design. The CTE Conference brings together educators to share innovative practices that encourage and empower students to excel.

OFFICIAL RULES FOR THE COVER CONTEST

- 1. Students currently enrolled in a Career Technical Education (CTE) graphic arts class are eligible to submit **ONE** entry. The maximum number of entries allowed is **ten (10) per teacher.**
- All entries must reflect the information in the three (3) header lines of this announcement and, in addition, need to include 1) the <u>CTE Logo</u>, which can be downloaded from the CTE Fall Conference website (cteconference.org), 2) the dates <u>November 16-18, 2022</u> and 3) location of the conference: <u>Omni</u> Rancho Las Palmas.
- 3. The maximum size of the submitted design is 8 1/2 x 11 inches. *The top three winners will be required to submit their work electronically and the first place winner may be requested to edit their work by the committee.*
- 4. Entries must be computer-developed using colors selected by the student.
 - a. If selected, you will need to provide CYMK numbers.
 - b. NOTE: Black may be used. The program will be printed on white stock.
- 5. The entry must be submitted on white paper-not mounted
- 6. All entries will be judged on:
 - a. Spelling (NOTE: Entries with misspellings will be disqualified).
 - b. Meeting all criteria of this contest
 - c. Creativity and the effective use of color
 - d. Craftsmanship, clarity, and neatness
 - e. Ability to be effectively printed/reproduced (jpeg)
- 7. Entries need to be received by **Thursday, March 31, 2022, 4:00 pm.,** in the office of North Orange County ROP, 385 N. Muller Street, Anaheim, CA 92801. Late entries will NOT be accepted.
- 8. The winners will be selected by the conference committee and will receive: **first place winner-\$500**, **second place \$350**, **and third place winner-\$150**. **In addition**, **up to three Honorable Mention winners will receive \$50**. The first, second, and third place winners will be recognized at the conference and all winners' artwork will be displayed.
- 9. Winners will be contacted via email. An announcement of the winners will be posted on the cteconference.org website by the end of April.
- 10. No artwork will be returned.
- 11. All submissions must be accompanied by the entry form **securely attached to the back of the artwork** (**staples, tape no paperclips**) containing all contact information, required signatures of the student, parent/legal guardian (if under 18), and teacher. Signatures grant the conference committee the right to use the winner's name, entry, and photograph for publicity purposes.
- 12. Entrants accept and agree to these rules. The decision of the committee shall be final.
- 13. Winning student agrees to make modifications to artwork requested by the conference committee in a timely manner.
